

ERRATA

Through oversight, in an article by Dr. T. Wingate Todd that appeared on pages 67, 68 and 69 of the April issue of *The Angle Orthodontist*, the illustration at the top of page 68, showing skull of a four month child appeared smaller than the following illustration showing skull of a nine month child. As a matter of fact, and as explained in the text, the four month skull was larger than the nine month skull.

In the same article there appeared a sentence reading . . . “. but no one would deny that disease *does not* have some detrimental effect on growth and development.” This should read, “. . . but no one would deny that disease *does* have some detrimental effect on growth and development.”

In the second paragraph on p. 69 skull 1801 is mistakenly referred to as “No. 180, the older”.
