M. DARRIL OPDAHL, D.D.S.

1932-1977

Memorial services were held for Darril Opdahl January 10, 1977 in Stockton, California.

Darril was graduated from the University of California Dental School in the Curriculum II program in 1957. Later he served for two years in the Air Force as a dentist before locating his orthodontic practice in Stockton, California.

Always a leader, Darril served as President of his component dental society, local Rotary Club and was president-elect, nominate of the Northern California Edward H. Angle Society at the time of his death.

A diplomate of the American Board of Orthodontics and intensely inter-

ested in orthodontics, Darril found much time to devote to dentistry in general. His service on many committees and as Trustee from the 19th District to the California Dental Association since 1968 attest to this. He had recently been honored for such service by election to Fellowship in the American College of Dentists.

Darril was a devoted family man and will be remembered by all who knew him for his compassion, forthright opinions and readiness to help in any situation.

He is survived by his parents, wife Pat and son Matthew, all residing in Stockton.
